

Tuning Into Your Learners: Assessment and Evaluation in the Lesson

Most teachers need to assess, evaluate and report on their learners in order to meet institutional or quality assurance requirements. In recent years, there has been much discussion of a more comprehensive and teacher-centred approach to the evaluation of learner progress. This approach, Learning Oriented Assessment, demonstrates how teachers' spontaneous and intuitive judgments have a complementary role to play to more formal modes of assessment.

This workshop aims to explore ways in which teachers can implement a Learning Oriented Assessment approach to teaching. We will focus on a variety of teaching skills and see how they can help us evaluate learners. The workshop will not suggest that teachers do anything new. It is more a question of how we can refine our current practice in order to achieve better quality assessment and better quality learning.
