

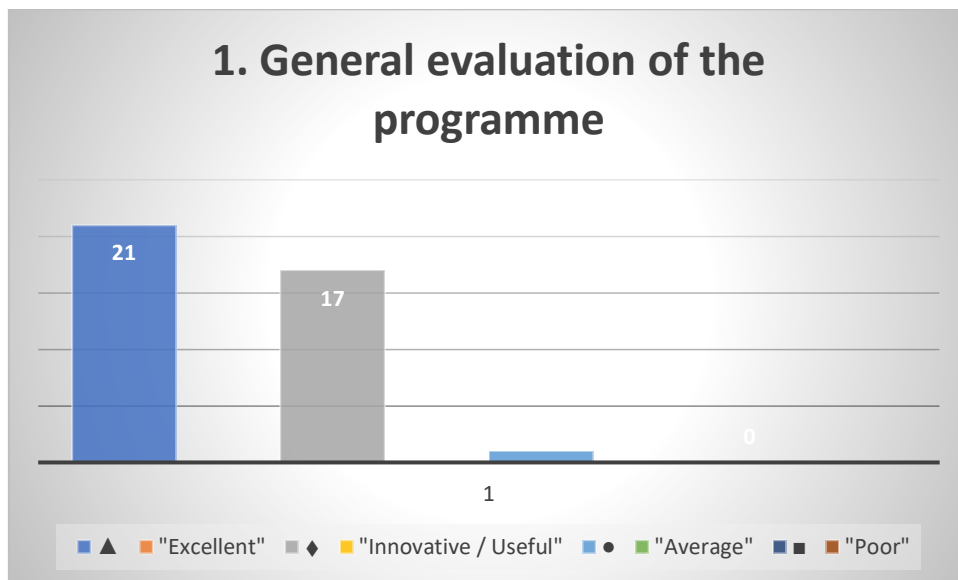
## RESULTS OF THE KAHOOT EVALUATION OF THE VI APABAL CONVENTION (13/04/18)

40 participants /10 questions

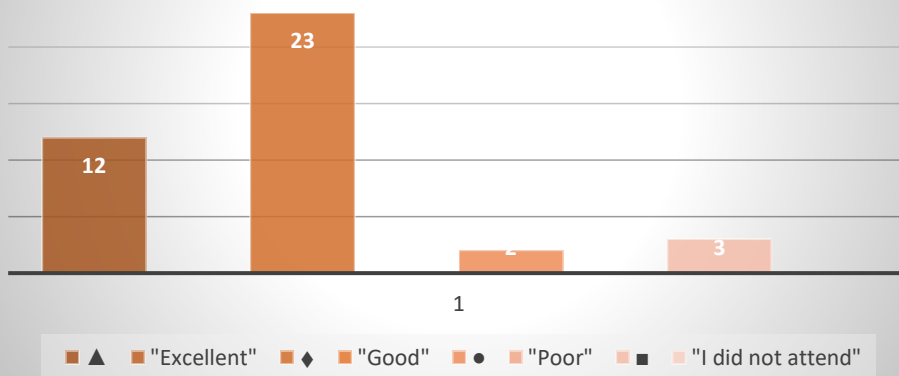
Most sessions were not plenaries, that is why participants could not attend to all of them.

### Summary of results:

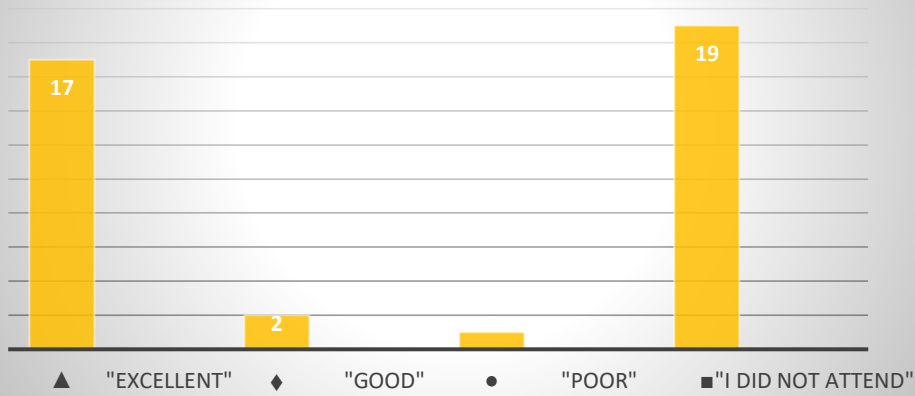
- All participants except one considered the programme excellent or innovative and useful.
- The sessions were very seldom rated as poor, only 1 or 2 people in some cases.
- Sessions 3, 5, 6 and 9 were considered to be excellent by the majority of respondents
- Sessions 2, 4 and 7 were considered to be good by the majority of respondents
- The best valued sessions have been number 6 , "The class is your stage.." by S. Hedstrom with 90% of excellents, number 3, "Survival and fantasy projects by L. Clanfield (89% of excellents) and number 9, "A to Z of English..." by S. Pickard with 80% of excellents.
- 21 out of 40 considered the content of the programme very adequate in relation to the Convention title, and the rest thought it was somehow related. Nobody thought it was not related at all.



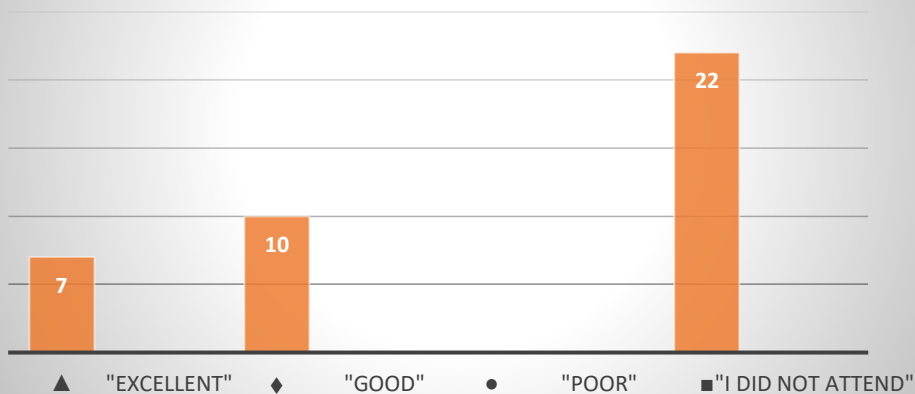

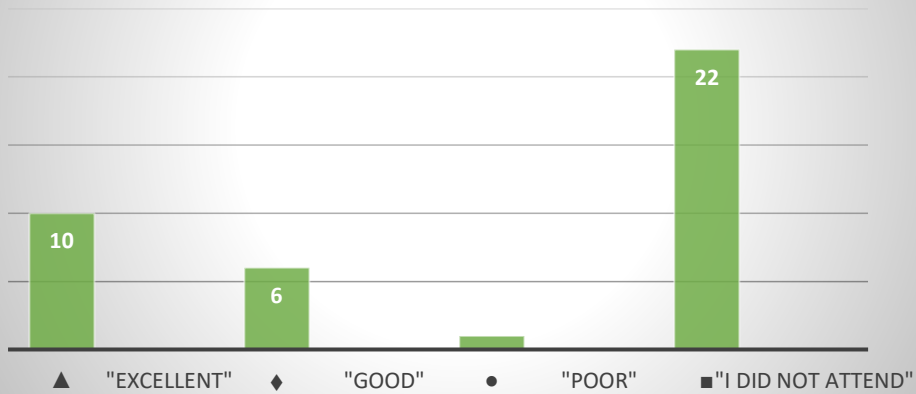

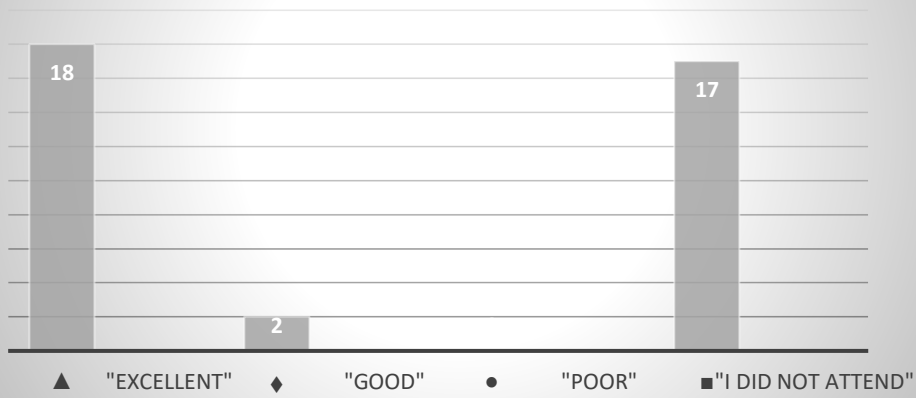
